*Our Grenache was planted in 2003 with the intention of using it in our Rhone blend, but we found we love the stuff so much on its own that we did a straight varietal bottling. One of our most difficult grapes to grow it requires extensive hand work, and diligent sorting of grapes prior to crushing. A mix of new and older barrels was used to influence but not overpower the delicate flavors.*

*Bramble berry flavors, silky soft tannins, beautiful baking spices and everything nice. Light to medium bodied with a lingering finish, this Spanish style grape makes a delicate and alluring wine.*



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
