<b>Wine makers notes</b>	<i>The Touriga Nacional was planted as one component of our Port. Lately I've noticed more Portuguese produces making dry reds so we decided to give it a try. I was pleasantly surprised by lovely fruit, ample body, and soft tannins. Planted in 2003, I believe that this wine will become bigger and more complex as the plant matures.</i>

*Huge overripe strawberry on the nose and palate are the first thing you'll notice, next is the Arena Valley terroir and supple fruit. This wine has nice, balanced acidity and a full, clean finish.*
